Responsibilities of a Team Captain

As team captain, we ask that you assist us in making this event a great time for all involved and below are some guidelines:

- 1. Captain Pack:** No packs are being out together with clubs receiving sufficient result sheets. Full details of the event including a list of teams and contacts are available at www.squashcanterbury.co.nz.
- 2. Be a Good host:** Make your opposition feel welcome with warm clean courts, a good supper, score sheets and cards and being ready to play 15 minutes early.
- 3. New balls please:** Each host team is required to start each tie with a new ball; this will make the event more enjoyable. Put those shiny rocks away!!!
- 4. Which Ball?:** The Dunlop Single Yellow is the official ball for all grades except for E Grade and below and Junior Divisions where the Prince Blue dot is encouraged.
- 5. Scoring:** PAR Scoring up to 15 points (win by 2 points), best of 5 games, will be in operation for Round 2.
- 6. Results:** Remember teams that do not complete their cards correctly will accrue a fine. Please ensure this is done. **Each club is issued with self addressed envelopes for results each night; please ensure they are deposited in this envelope and if you are posting them, they are posted the next day.**
- 7. Team management:** Ensure your team is all ready to go each week on time; there is nothing worse than getting defaulted to or waiting for your opponent.
- 8. Special Deals:** Each team member will receive a discount card courtesy of Robbies on Riccarton in round 1. If you haven't received one let us know and we will sort you out.
- 9. Communicate:** We have made every effort to make the draw fair and correct. However with over 180 teams and a bottleneck of teams at some venues there will be occasions where anomalies will occur.
- 10. Finals Weekend is on the 29th & 30th August.** A draw will be circulated closed to time.
