

## Spring 2019

- **Supper:** The first player listed on the weekly draw is to provide supper. *Please note, \*when playing at the New Christchurch Squash Club, each player must pay \$5 towards supper provided by the Cashmere Club. Payment is made at the bar, ideally all at once by the team captain. You are unable to bring your own food onto the premise, as it does not meet the food license requirements for the Cashmere club, that runs the bar and kitchen.*
- **Most Improved player:** Awards will be presented at the last week for the most improved girl and boy.
- **Refereeing:** All interclub players must have completed either the Squash NZ club's online referee exam or attend 2 junior rules and referee's session 's per year these will be held the first week of each interclub round.
